“SISTERS OF MINE” PREPARES FOR 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE 19TH AMENDMENT

Shared Radiance Performing Arts Company has assembled a diverse group of actors, writers, and musicians and developed a Performance Montage called "Sisters of Mine" in partnership with the North Carolina branch of the American Association of University Women (the AAUW). Sherri Raeford, Artistic Director, will direct the piece. It will be performed at the Governor's Mansion as well as other venues throughout North Carolina in 2020.

The performance piece is a compilation of monologues, scenes, poems, and music based on their collective research on instrumental women surrounding the Women's Suffrage Movement. The piece features several North Carolina women as well as other instrumental women who helped bring about the Nineteenth Amendment. Issues of diversity and the inclusion of women that aren't highlighted often in the history of women's suffrage are addressed as well. There are so many stories to tell, including some that have been pushed aside. This ensemble strives to show an honest and insightful look at the events and women of our past and present.

MEET OUR PLAYERS: DAVID MERRITT JR

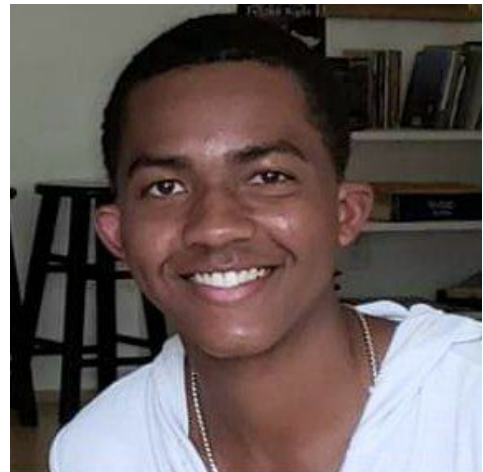
The seasoned ShakesCollage actor discusses his hidden talents, his future, and Spider-Man.
